Unimmunized staff may resume work at the affected home as soon as they are taking antiviral prophylaxis. Unimmunized staff not receiving prophylactic therapy must wait one incubation period (3 days) from the last day that they worked at the outbreak facility/unit prior to working in a non-outbreak facility.
