

Position Title: Student Safe Sewage Public Health Inspector

Salary: \$17.00 per hour, 35 hours per week

Assignment:

The Student will work under the guidance of Public Health Inspectors to assist in the maintenance inspections of on-site sewage re-inspection program that is administered by Peterborough Public Health.

Minimum qualifications and position requirements:

- Enrolled in/or completed a Bachelor of Applied Science (Environmental Health) Program;
- Ministry of Municipal Affairs (MMA) Part 8 Technical Certificate;
- Pleasure Craft Operator Card;
- Must possess a valid G driver's licence and have access to reliable transportation to meet the position's needs.
- Evidence of vehicle insurance including business use insurance.
- Demonstrated effective ability to do the following:
 - must possess good written, oral communication skills, have the ability to co-ordinate daily
 activities and work independently; and
 - apply initiative, tact, diplomacy, and judgement in work related and work impacted engagements; and
 - carry/lift items up to 80 pounds.

Duties will include:

- Converse with property owners and the public.
- Perform effective on-site review of facilities and provide opinion on system operation.
- Obtain field measurements as required.
- Prepare journals of completed "inspections".
- Prepare site inspection reports/sketches.
- Take photos as required in addition to site review.
- Maintain care for equipment/vehicles as required.
- Practice workplace safety, including in the field.
- Read maps and use Global Positioning System (GPS).
- Exhibit polite and respectful attitude.
