			Other businesses allowed to remain open to the public during the lockdown must limit the number of people occupying any room open to the public to 50% capacity.
			Businesses must ensure that capacity is limited so that every member of the public is able to maintain a physical distance of 2 metres from every other person.
			Signage must be posted in a visible location to the public that states the maximum capacity the business is permitted to operate under.
