



COVID-19 Public Health Guidance: What to look for when checking Proof of Vaccine and ID


Context:

To access select settings in Ontario, Proof of Vaccination showing someone is fully vaccinated against COVID-19 is necessary. To confirm the proof is valid, personal identification will also be used.

Proof of Vaccination (Check box if complete):

- Individual's name and date of birth are included, and match personal identification (see page 2)
- Brand of vaccine is listed (e.g. Pfizer/Comirnaty, Moderna/Spikevax)
- Number of valid doses received is indicated
 - Check if # of doses meets fully vaccinated criteria. 1, 2, or 3 doses depending on brand
- Date (s) vaccination was received is clear, with it being at least 14 days since the last dose was administered

Personal Identification reference:

- Name matches proof of vaccination
- Date of Birth matches proof of vaccination

Some examples of valid ID include (but are not limited to):

- Birth certificate
- Citizenship card
- Driver's licence
- Government (Ontario or other) issued identification card, including health card
- Indian Status Card /Indigenous Membership Card
- Passport
- Permanent Resident card

In short, proof of identity can be established using documentation issued by an institution or public body, provided it includes the name of the holder and date of birth

Medical Exemptions to Vaccination (If Applicable):

- Name of the person on the note matches the name on personal identification
- Completed by a physician (MD) or registered nurse in the extended class (RNEC) with their name and contact information included
- Uses logo or letterhead identifying the MD or RNEC
- Statement that there is a medical reason for exemption from being fully vaccinated
- Effective time-period for the medical reason is included, with date range including the current day
