TO: All Owners, Operators and Persons Responsible for food premises with indoor or outdoor dining areas located in the City of Peterborough and County of Peterborough

RE: RESCINDED – Medical Officer of Health Instructions for the collection of patron contact information

Effective immediately, I, Dr. Thomas Piggott, Medical Officer of Health for Peterborough Public Health, am rescinding the Letter of Instruction issued on September 16, 2021 (amended October 13, 2021) to local food and/or drink establishments requiring the mandatory collection of patron information for contact tracing.

All food and/or drink establishments are advised to adhere to the provincial public health measures set forth in [Ontario Regulation 263/20: Rules for Areas in Step 2](#), in effect as of January 5, 2022, which includes the requirement for the collection of patron information for the purpose of contact tracing.
