

COVID-19 Vaccine – Frequently Asked Questions

Ages 5-11



Question	Answer
Will my child experience any side effects from the COVID-19 vaccine?	 Like any vaccination, mild side effects are to be expected and can last 1-3 days. They include: Redness or swelling in the arm Tiredness, muscle soreness Headache or mild fever This is the result of the immune system recognizing the vaccine and building up its defense. Those defenses will help you later if you come into contact with a COVID-19 virus.
Why should my child receive the COVID-19 vaccine?	 The COVID-19 vaccine Protects against infection and severe disease caused by the COVID-19 virus Reduces the amount of time your child may need to isolate if they come into contact with someone who has COVID-19 Can reduce chances of transmitting COVID-19 to others
I hear COVID-19 symptoms are milder in children. Why do we need to vaccinate them?	Thankfully, we often see milder symptoms in children than older adults. However, this is not always the case. In any age, cases can experience severe symptoms and some experience long lasting symptoms. The COVID-19 vaccine can reduce the chances of infection and can reduce the
	risk of experiencing moderate to severe symptoms of COVID-19.
What is a vaccine safety signal? Have there been any concerning safety signals identified for the paediatric (5-11) COVID-19 vaccine?	A "safety signal" is a bit of information that is shared with Health Canada that would indicate a vaccine or medication may impact health.
	To date, millions of children in Canada and the US have received the paediatric COVID-19 vaccine and there have been no safety signals identified .
How do we know the COVID-19 vaccine is safe for kids 5-11 years old?	Health Canada has approved this vaccine after rigorous testing. They only approve vaccines if they are safe, effective, and will be of benefit to the individual.
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Can the COVID-19 vaccine impact my child's fertility?	NO. There is no evidence to suggest that the COVID-19 vaccine will impact a person's fertility.
