

Masters of Public Health Student Practicums x2

Overall description:	These 16 week placements offer a unique opportunity for students to learn about public health management within their professional field of study. Supervision will be provided by senior administrators with opportunities for mentoring by program staff. Both focuses noted below reference organizational learning opportunities including weekly teaching session with the Medical Officer of Health.
Begin/End Period:	May 1, 2022, to August 18, 2023 (16 weeks or 560 hours).
Payment:	\$10,000 stipend.
Location:	TBD. The level or need for in-person work will be variable for each project.

Practicum Descriptions:

- Summer Practicum Epidemiology Focus. Working with the Epidemiology team, you will support
 projects to strengthen communicable disease and drug poisoning crisis data reporting and
 dashboards. COVID-19 work has significantly changed public reporting and Peterborough Public
 Health has created innovative epidemiology tools such as the COVID-19 Risk Index. You will work
 with and support our team of epidemiologists on key projects related to this work.
- 2. **Summer Practicum Indigenous Health Policy Focus**. Supporting the Peterborough Public Health Indigenous Health Advisory Circle, you will work to support projects focused on Indigenous health equity, anti-racism in health care and support for Indigenous engagement in public health for urban Indigenous peoples and residents of Curve Lake and Hiawatha First Nations.
