Peterborough Public Health School Oral Health Screening Program

Oral Health Screenings are done in all Elementary schools every year by a Public Health Registered Dental Hygienist.

WHY

- School oral health screenings are designed to support and encourage parent's efforts to provide the best dental care for their children.
- **Teeth are important!** We link eligible children and youth to **FREE** dental treatment programs.
- Oral health screenings are performed in accordance with the Ontario Public Health Standards under the Health Protection and Promotion Act.

WHO

- All students in JK, SK, Grade 2, 4, and 7 will be screened.
- Any student referred in the previous year.
- Any additional students can also be screened at parent/guardian request.

WHAT

- Dental screenings are visual assessments only and do not replace your child's regular dental examination with a dentist.
- You will be notified if your child requires urgent dental care or preventive dental services.
- Sterilized mouth mirrors are used for each student.



Parents/Guardians will receive information from their child's school at least 10 days prior to the screening.

WHERE

Most dental screenings are done in your child's school; however, it can also be scheduled at the Peterborough Public Health Community Dental Clinic.
