


Highlights of cases in Ontario

- There are 5,759 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Ontario reported to date in iPHIS. This represents an increase of 483 confirmed cases from the previous report.
 - o 45.5% of cases are male, 53.8% are female.
 - o 37.4% of cases are 60 years of age and older.
 - o Greater Toronto Area public health units account for 52.5% of cases.
- 12.5% of cases were hospitalized
- 200 deaths have been reported (please note there may be a reporting delay for deaths in iPHIS). This is an increase of 26 deaths from the previous report.
- Sixty-nine outbreaks have been reported in long-term care homes.


