Assignment:

The Student will work under the guidance of Public Health Inspectors to carry out activities required by the Ontario Public Health Standards related to Food Safety, Safe Water, Rabies Prevention and Control, Health Hazard Prevention and Management and Infectious Diseases Prevention and Control. This opportunity qualifies as field training for the purpose of meeting the practicum requirements of the Board of Certification of the Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors.

Qualifications:

- Enrolled in/or completed a Bachelor of Applied Science (Environmental Health) Program.
- Must possess and demonstrate competent written and oral communication skills and have the ability to co-ordinate daily activities effectively.
- Must possess and demonstrate excellent interpersonal and conflict resolution skills.
- Demonstrated knowledge of applicable legislation.
- Self-motivated and able to complete assigned duties independently and as part of a team, as required.
- Ability to wear personal protective equipment (PPE), as required and as appropriate.

- Must possess a valid driver's licence and have access to reliable transportation to meet the position's needs.
- Must provide proof of vaccination with a COVID-19 vaccine series.
