Vaccine Schedule:			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● HPV-9 vaccine is a two-dose series (0, 6 months) when initiated before the age of 15. If the series is initiated at age 15 or older, HPV is a three-dose series (0, 2, and 6 months) ● Hepatitis B vaccine is a two-dose series (0, 6 months) when completed between the ages of 11-15 years. For children who have not received a 2nd dose prior to their 16th birthday, a 3-dose series is required. ● Men-C-ACYW135 is a single-dose vaccine. This is different from the meningococcal vaccine that is routinely given at one year of age.
