Near café/train tracks - in public washrooms.

Outside public washrooms.

Outside public washrooms.

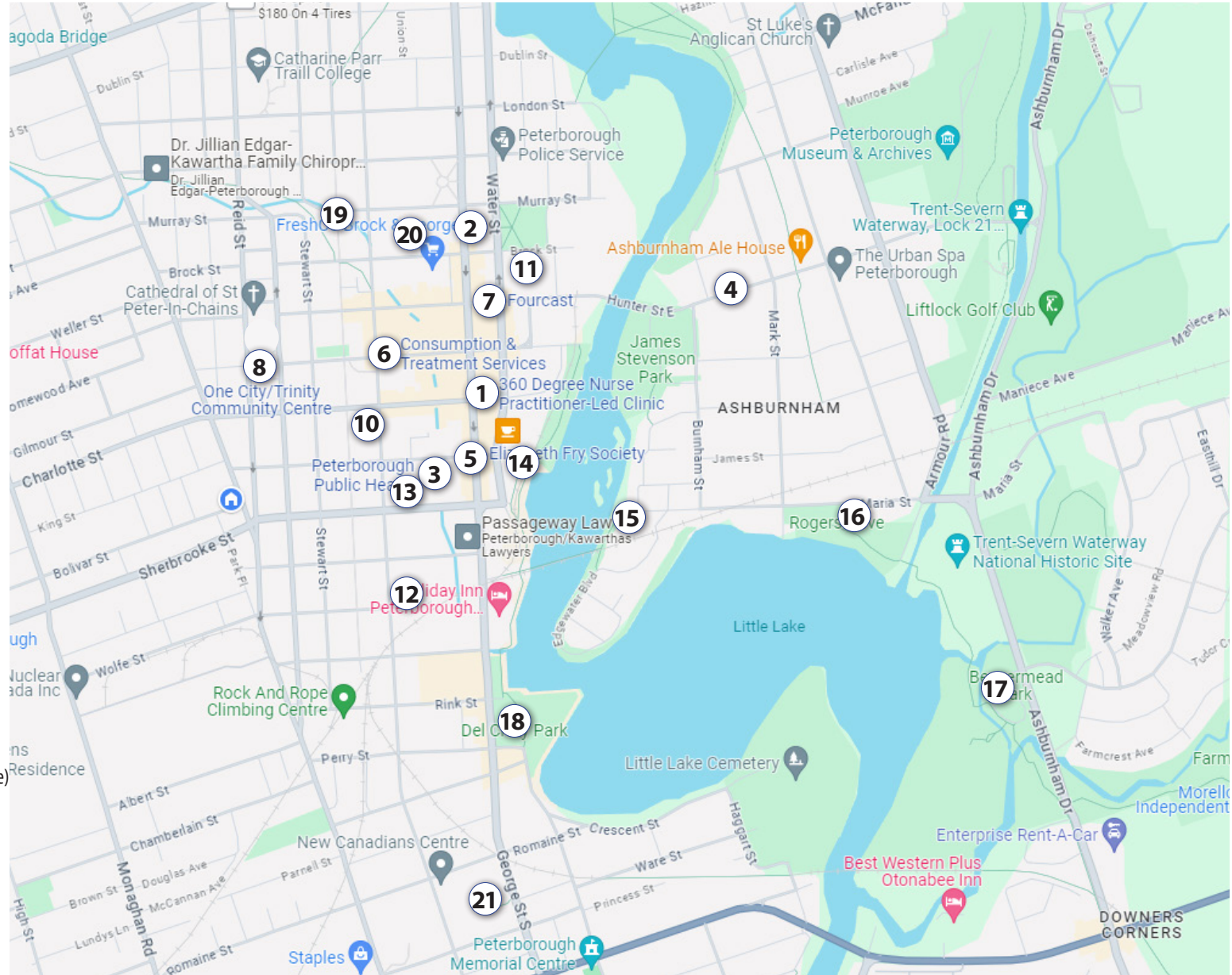
